## NOTIFICATION

The 31st August 1995

No. 19267—2R/1-81/94(pt-I)-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the Orissa Government servants Conduct Rules, 1959, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct (Amendment) Rules, 1995.
- (2) These rules shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.
2. In the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959, in Rule 21.—
  - (i) after Note 4 appearing under Sub-Rule (4), the following Note shall be inserted, Namely:—
 

“Note 5—Notwithstanding anything contained in this Sub-Rule, every Government Servant, after his/her marriage, shall make a true and complete declaration of his/her assets afresh in the Prescribed form within three months of marriage, ”and;
  - (ii) the existing Note 5 appearing below Sub-Rule (4) shall be renumbered as Note 6.

The main objects and constitution of Board will be as under:—

## Main objects of the Board

- (a) Co-ordinating the works of Zilla Sainik Boards in the State.
- (b) Promoting measures for the welfare and resettlement of Ex-Servicemen and families of serving/deceased personnels of the Armed forces.
- (c) Disseminating information to the general public regarding the Armed forces in the country and for taking measures to raise an intelligent interest in the Armed forces amongst the members of the general public.
- (d) Administering the Zilla Sainik Boards in the State in accordance with the Rules and instructions prescribed by the Central and State Government.
