

Counting of military service rendered  
before or after the war in conjunction  
with war service for pension.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to your letter No.6 III-A., dated 19.3.1952 on the above subject addressed to the Secretary to the Government of Orissa, Home Department and to say that neither the State Government nor the Government of India have issued any orders regarding counting of military service rendered by Government servant before and after the last war in conjunction with war service for civil pension. There may, however, be no objection to cases of Government servants who have rendered military service in conjunction with war service before the 3rd September, 1939 and after the 1st April, 1946 being decided on the analogy of the orders communicated in the Finance Department memo no.1059-1946 F., dated 17.6.1936 (copy enclosed).




