#### NOTIFICATION

The 24th May 1977

S. O. No. 403/77--In exercise of the power conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959, namely:

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct (Amendment) Rules, 1977.
2. They shall come into force at once.
2. After rule 14 of the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959 the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“14A. No Government Servant shall—

- (i) give or take or abet the giving or taking of dowry; or
- (ii) demand directly or indirectly, from the parents or guardian of a bride or bridegroom, as the case may be, any dowry.

Explanation - For the purposes of this rule, 'Dowry' has the same meaning as in the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 (28 of 1961) ”
