NOTIFICATION

No. 26303—SC/6-2/99-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Civil Services (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990, namely:—

- (i) These rules may be called the Orissa Civil Services (Rehabilitation Assistance) Amendment Rules, 1999.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

In the Orissa Civil Services (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), after sub-clause (v) of clause (b) of rule 2 the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(vi) Brother of unmarried Government servant who was wholly dependent on such Government servant at the time of death”.

In the said rules, in rule 9—

- (i) for sub-rule (7) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(7) If at the time of death of the Government servant, there is a ward who is minor and who alone is available in the family of the deceased Government servant for employment, he/she shall apply for a job under these rules on attaining the age of eighteen years and in no case beyond three years from the date of attaining the age of eighteen years”; and

- (ii) for sub-rule (11) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

(11) Notwithstanding the period of limitation prescribed in sub-rule 6, delay not exceeding 12 months in submission of application for appointment under these rules may be condoned by the Administrative Department and delay exceeding twelve months may be condoned by the Chief Minister.
