Subject:- Re-employment of retired Government Servants.

Ref:- P & S Department Resolution No. 24497/Gen,
dated 16th October, 1979.

Sir,

It has come to the notice of Government that doubts have arisen regarding interpretation of Political and Services Department resolution referred to above, allowing re-employment to retired Government employees till 60 years after superannuation.

2. While considering the question of man-power strategy during the Sixth Plan period it was felt that there would be extreme dearth of technical and para-technical personnel in some of the Departments of Government especially in the sphere of veterinary, agriculture and medicine etc, causing avoidable delay in execution of Plan schemes.

3. With a view to tide over the above dearth of trained technical personnel, Government took a decision that personnel belonging to the aforesaid categories could be re-employed after their superannuation up to the age of 60 years. It was never the intention of Government that this principle should be applied to all Services in a general manner.

4. The Administrative Departments are, accordingly, requested to exercise their judgement while considering re-employment of retired personnel. This should not be resorted to as a matter of routine manner.
