Whereas Government in their Resolution No. 32538, dated the 16th November 1988 have entrusted the work of conducting various recruitment examinations and selection of candidates for various Class-III posts to the Board of Examiners under the Board of Revenue and;

Whereas the said Board of Examiners have not conducted necessary examination and the candidates of the select list prepared by the Revenue Divisional Commissioner could not be provided with appointment.

Now, therefore, Government in pursuance of rule 2 (d) of the above rule, have been pleased to extend operation of the rule to all the Heads of Departments ordered that the select list prepared by the R. D. C. shall be deemed to have been prepared by the Board of Examiners. The Board on Examiners shall republish the select list and allot candidates to all Heads of Departments in order of merit from the said list and the concerned Heads of Department shall issue necessary appointment orders accordingly.

The said select list shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of its re-publication by the Board of Examiners.

No. 31486—2R/1/51/89-Gen.—Whereas the Revenue Divisional Commissioner, Central Division had conducted the recruitment examination during the year 1988-89 for selection of candidates for the post of Junior Stenographers in pursuance of the provisions of the Orissa Stenographers' Service (Recruitment and conditions of service of Personal Assistants and Stenographers in the office of the Heads of Departments and District offices) Rules, 1982 for appointment as such in the offices of the Heads of Departments and District offices under the Revenue Department.

And, whereas the above referred Rule of 1982 having been repealed by Orissa Heads of Department Stenographers' Service (Recruitment and condition of service of Stenographers) Rules, 1988, appointment of the candidates out of the list prepared by the Revenue Divisional Commissioner could not be implemented and the authorities empowered under the new rule have not yet conducted necessary examination for selection of candidates.

Now, therefore Government in exercise of the powers conferred under rule 24 of the Orissa Heads of Department Stenographers Service (Recruitment and conditions of service of Private Secretaries, Personal Assistant and Stenographers) Rules, 1988 have been pleased to relax the operation of the provisions of Rule 4, 5 (1) and 10 of the said rule and ordered that the list prepared by the Revenue Divisional Commissioner shall be deemed to have been prepared by the Board Examiners under the Board of Revenue under the said Rules of 1988. The Board of Examiners shall republish the select list and allot candidates to different Heads of Departments in order of merit from the list and the concerned Head of Departments shall issue necessary appointment orders accordingly.

Further, Government, in exercise of the powers conferred under rule 21 of the Orissa District and Sub-ordinate offices Stenographers Service (Recruitment and condition of service of Stenographer) Rules, 1988, have also been pleased to relax the operation of the provision of Rule 4, 5 (1) and 8 of the said rule and order that the Board of Revenue shall, after allotment of candidates to different Heads of Departments, shall forward the list of candidates of different districts to the respective Collectors for being allotted to different District/Rango and sub-ordinate offices and the concerned authorities shall issue necessary appointment orders.
