Sub:- Procedure to be followed for making temporary posts permanent.

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to the Political and Services (General) Department Resolution No. 3660-Gen., dated the 26th March, 1960 regarding the principles for making temporary posts permanent and to say that the question as to the procedure to be followed before the temporary posts are actually made permanent was under review in Finance Deptt. Hitherto it was the established practice to obtain Legislative approval by submitting a 'NIL' demand schedule. After careful consideration, Government have been pleased to decide that conversion of temporary posts into permanent ones is a mere executive act and as such does not require specific approval of the Legislature. There is, therefore, no need for the preparation of demand schedules in the matter.

The posts may henceforward be made permanent as and when they satisfy the conditions enumerated in the Political and Services (General) Department Resolution No. 3660-Gen., dated the 26th March, 1960, referred to above.

All draft sanction orders relating to the conversion of temporary posts into permanent posts should be referred to Finance Department and their concurrence obtained before the sanction orders issue.
