RESOLUTION

The 17th January 1976

SUBJECT—Recognition of various Sanskrit Examinations conducted by the Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi for purpose of employment under the State Government.

The question of recognising examinations conducted by Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi, as equivalent to educational qualification in the general educational set up of the State for the purpose of employment was under the active consideration of Government for some time past. After careful consideration of the matter and in consultation with the Orissa Public Service Commission it has now been decided that the "Sashtri" and "Acharya" degrees awarded by the Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi shall be considered equivalent to B. A. and M. A. degrees of Indian Universities respectively for the purpose of all employments under the State Government in all categories of posts. The relevant rules regulating recruitment shall be amended accordingly.

ORDER—Ordered that the Resolution be published in the next issue of the *Orissa Gazettee* for general information and copies be forwarded to all Departments/Heads of Departments/Secretary, Orissa Public Service Commission.
