NOTIFICATION

Bhubaneswar, dated the 7-9 ~~August~~, 1992.

No. R/1-22/92 33634 /Gen., In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules to amend the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) Rules, 1991 namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

2. In rule 5 of the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) Rules, 1991 in sub-rule (2), for clause (i) including the provisos, the following clause shall be substituted, namely :-

"(i) Candidates shall be under thirty-two years and over twenty-one years of age on the 1st day of August of the year in which applications are invited :

Provided that -

(a) Where applications have not been invited by the Commission during any particular year, applicants who would be eligible if applications would have been invited during that year, shall be eligible to compete at the examination held in the subsequent year.

- (b) the maximum age limit in case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled castes or Scheduled Tribes shall be relaxed by five years ; and
- (c) the upper age limit in case of candidates, who are ex-servicemen, shall be relaxed in accordance with the Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985."
