NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of recruitment of Junior Assistants in the offices of Heads of Departments) Rules, 1975; namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment of Junior Assistants in the offices of Heads of Departments) (Amendment) Rules, 1985.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

2. In the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of recruitment of Junior Assistants in the offices of Heads of Departments) Rules, 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for rule 9, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :-

"9. (1) Standard and syllabus of the examination

The examination shall consist of the following subjects carrying marks as shown against each :-

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Marks</u>
(a) Language	100
(b) Arithmetic	100
(c) General Knowledge and Intelligence test.	100

(2) The syllabus and the standard of examination for each subject specified in sub-rule (1) shall be as shown in the Appendix".

3. In the said rules, for the existing Appendix, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

" APPENDIX

( See rule 9 )

Standard and syllabus for competitive examination :-

1. LANGUAGE

- (a) An essay to be written in Oriya on one of the subjects mentioned in the question paper. 30 marks
- (b) A letter to be written in English on one of the subjects mentioned in the question paper. 20 marks
- (c) A letter to be written in Oriya on one of the subjects mentioned in the question paper. 20 marks
- (d) Summary or precis of one English passage mentioned in the question paper. 10 marks
- (e) Summary or precis of one Oriya passage mentioned in the question paper. 10 marks
- (f) One English passage to be translated into Oriya. 10marks

NOTE :- The standard shall be equal to that of the Intermediate examination of the Utkal University.

2. ARITHMATIC :- Vulgar fractions and decimals, H.C.F. and L.C.M., Simple and compound practices, simple and compound interests, percentage, profit and loss, mixtures, partnership, average rates and taxes, insurance square and cubic measures, problems on time and work and time and distance.

NOTE:- The standard shall be of Matriculation examination Problems more easily solvable by algebraical method need not be solved arithmetically.
