R E S O L U T I O N

Dated, Bhubaneswar the 4th May, 1988

Sub:- Principles for Promotion and Fixation of Seniority of Ministerial Officers in the Offices of Heads of Departments.

In this Department Resolution No. 2R/1-62/87-22237/Gen dated the 24th September, 1987, it was stipulated that

- (a) no Junior Assistant shall be promoted to the rank of Senior Assistant unless he has put in at least three years of continuous service as such, is considered fit to perform all the duties of a Senior Assistant and has passed the Preliminary Accounts Examination conducted by the Board of Revenue, and
- (b) no Senior Assistant shall be considered for promotion to the post of Section Officer, Level II unless he has rendered a minimum of twelve years of service inclusive of nine years of continuous service as a Senior Assistant and has passed the Final Accounts Examination conducted by the Board of Revenue.

2. The requirement of passing the Preliminary and Final Accounts Examination did not exist prior to the issue of the Resolution under reference. While Government are of the view that this requirement is necessary and should be retained as an essential condition of eligibility for


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promotion, they have decided on a temporary and conditional relaxation of this requirement so that there is no difficulty in filling up the vacancies that have arisen and will arise in the near future and Junior and Senior Assistants, who had not taken steps to pass these examinations, are allowed sometime to do so.

3. Government have accordingly been pleased to order that the requirement of passing the Preliminary and Final Accounts Examinations shall be kept in abeyance for a period of three years from the date of issue of the Resolution under reference. Promotions to the posts of Senior Assistants and Section Officers, Level II during this period shall be made on the basis of the other criteria referred to under (a) and (b) of paragraph 1 above but all such promotions shall be ad hoc and subject to the condition that the person concerned shall be reverted to the grade from which he was promoted unless he passes the relevant examination during this period. Those who pass the relevant examination will be continued in the higher post. On the expiry of the aforesaid period of three years no person who does not fulfil all the conditions of eligibility shall be considered for promotion.


ORDER - Ordered that this Resolution be published in the Orissa Gazette for general information and copies forwarded to all Departments of Government and all Heads of Departments.


