Sir,

With reference to your letter No.9784 A.,
dated 27th April, 1961 on the subject mentioned above, I
am directed to say that the restriction imposed in respect
of Police officers and Assistants of the Police Department
in paragraph 3 of the P.&S. Department Circular letter no.
2222 (74) Gen., dated 23.2.61, to appear at the I.A., I.Com.,
B.A., and B.Com. Examinations privately was further examined
by Government. It has now been decided to relax the said
restriction. The Police personnel both Gazetted and non-g
gazetted, including the Ministerial Officers serving under
the administrative control of the Inspector General of
Police may now appear at the said Examination privately
subject to the conditions prescribed in the said Circular
2. They have further been pleased to authorise the Inspector
General of Police until further orders to permit the non-
gazetted Police officers and men including the Ministerial
officers serving under the Police Department under his
administrative control subject to the conditions prescribed
in the said Circular.

3. The Registrar, Utkal University, is being informed of
the orders.
