Sub:- Rehabilitation assistance to the family members of a Govt. employee who dies or suffers any disability while in service.

Instructions were issued by this Department vide Resolution No. 21684 Dt. 9.9.82 and Govt. order No. 24052 Dt. 19.10.83 that rehabilitation assistance may be provided to the family member(s) of Govt. servants who die or suffer permanent incapacitation while in service provided he/she should possess the minimum educational qualification prescribed for the post.

The minimum educational qualification for the post of a Peon and such other Class-IV employees has been prescribed as passing of M.E. Examination vide this Department Govt. order No. 29787 Dt. 15.12.79. In view of this, it has come to the notice of the Govt. that difficulties are being experienced by some appointing authorities to provide such assistance when the wife seeks rehabilitation assistance and does not possess the requisite educational qualification.


Government are aware that quite often wives of Class-IV Govt. servants do not have scope of education at the high school level. Insisting on the prescribed requisite qualification in their case will defeat the spirit and purpose of rehabilitation appointment.

After careful consideration Govt. have been pleased to relax the provisions contained in the above cited Govt. order and to decide that the wife of a Class-IV Govt. servant seeking a Class-IV job under this scheme should be eligible for appointment provided she has passed at least lower primary examination.

This instruction may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
