Subject :- Verification of Character and antecedents
of candidates for appointment under
Government - change in the procedure.

Sir,

I am directed to invite reference to this Department memo no. 1124-(94) - Gen., dated 25.1.62 which prescribes that the attestation forms of the candidates for verification of character and antecedents should be sent only to the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner concerned, who will consult the D.I.G., C.I.D., and the District Superintendent of Police to find out from them, if they have in the records anything adverse against the candidates. With the creation of the post of the Additional Inspector-General of Police, Intelligence (Special Branch) Orissa, Cuttack it has been decided by Government that for the verification of character and antecedents of candidates the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner may consult the Additional Inspector-General of Police, Intelligence (Special Branch) instead of the D.I.G., C.I.D.

I am, therefore, to request that the present decision of Government may kindly be followed.
